### Experience

Bill is a graduate of North Carolina State University ('83) where he received his BS in Civil Engineering, and the University of Colorado in Denver ('87) where he received his MS in Civil Engineering. While living in Denver, Mr. Fuller worked for Bierbach Engineers for several years where his emphasis was on hospital and multi-story designs.

In 1987, Mr. Fuller returned east to join CRS Sirrinc in Greenville, SC. In the early 1990's, three dimensional computer software was just beginning to be developed for the Architectural-Engineering industry to use in building design. Mr. Fuller received training in the new software in Huntsville, AL and returned to help the CRSS Structural Department implement the development of this new technology. Mr. Fuller subsequently produced major 3d design projects for Philip Morris in Charlotte, NC and Scott Paper in Owensboro, KY. In 1993, Mr. Fuller joined Cary Engineering where his design emphasis was in educational and industrial projects.

Mr. Fuller started his own consulting business in 1997. Fuller Consulting Engineers, Inc. was created to provide structural engineering services to those in the building design industry. The business has grown to provide services in over thirty-seven states.

Green Building design is also an interest of Mr. Fuller's and as a LEED accredited professional, he has participated in multiple LEED projects throughout South Carolina. Recently, the new Upstate Forever headquarters in Greenville received a Platinum certification, only the second project in South Carolina to do so to date.

In addition to running the company in Greenville, Mr. Fuller still takes an active role in project management and in the engineering of projects.
